Laconia was platted in 1816 by John Boone with 64 lots. It was the commercial center of the area and the distribution center for mail brought in by the L&N Railroad, which ran on the Kentucky side of the Ohio River.

Laconia at one time boasted two churches, three general stores, one on each corner of the town square, three hotels, several millinery stores, two doctors, a funeral parlor, and a saloon. The Laconia General Store, built in 1927, is the only remaining commercial building operating on the square.
