**Stephenson's General Store – Lunch/SAG  
Stop (mile 35.7)**

**The store** has been a community landmark since the early 1900's and continues to maintain old charm with modern conveniences. They have an old ice cream bar, deli, antiques, pottery, pizza and hot foods. You won't believe their antique cookie jar collection. The display of Leavenworth's history is interesting including a nice display of photos from the 1937 flood.

**Corydon** served as the 2nd capital of the Indiana Territory and the first state capital until 1925 (m. 14).

After a devastating fire in 1960 the current grandstand at the Harrison County Fairgrounds was purchased from the minor league baseball team from Parkway Field in Louisville. (m.14.3)

Corydon was the site of the only Civil War battle fought in Indiana after Gen. John Hunt Morgan crossed the Ohio River from Kentucky on July 9, 1863. The memorial park is on Old 135 just past this route's right turn onto Heidelberg Road at mile 14.7.

**Harrison Spring** is Indiana's largest spring and produces at least 3 million gallons of water per day. It was once part of a 600 acre farm owned by U.S. President Wm. Henry Harrison (m 45.1).

Although its wheel had already been sent to a Catholic diocese in SE Asia, **Rothrock Mill** was demolished in 1986 after years of abandonment. The stone columns that supported the mill are still present (m. 50.4).
