Jug Rock is a natural geological formation near the East Fork of the White River. Composed of sandstone, it is the largest free-standing table rock formation (or "tea table") in the U.S. east of the Mississippi River. It is part of the Mansfield formation, laid down in the Pennsylvanian epoch (~ 325 to 286 million years ago). Erosion along fracture lines separated it from a nearby cliff.
